VILE PLAY "THE PILGRIM" IS BARRED BY KLANSMEN OF WALLA WALLA, WASH.

Portland Preachers, However, Sit Goggle-Eyed Before Spectacular Outrage, Swallowing Charlie Chaplin's Abominable Insults Without Blinking.

One hundred dollars' reward will be paid by the patriotic societies of Walla Walla County to anyone who first calls attention to a moving picture shown in a Walla Walla theatre which portrays any Catholic priest or Roman Catholic religious service in an undignified manner, or ridicules such service in the slightest degree.

Read it and weep, ye weak-kneed Protestants—the accompanying article from Walla Walla, where Klannish hoars were so courageous that the vile film play, "The Pilgrim," was barred by the Arcade Theatre. It was shown in Portland, however, at the Liberty. The Protestant audiences, including many preachers, sat open-mouthed, swallowing the stream of atrocious insults presented to them in picture form by the organized Kike-Catholic movie producers. They swallowed it without blinking, and smacked their lips with gusto.

Ye Gods! It was of such persons that Shakespeare wrote, when he declared that "they imitate humanity abominably."

If the Protestant ministers of Portland as a whole, as represented by their Ministerial Association, have no respect for the cloth which they wear, how can they expect the general public to respect them? How can anyone believe or pay any attention to what they preach? Have they no sense of duty as citizens, as Americans? There are a few notable exceptions among them, who act the part of real men and true Americans. Let us hope that in the future they will, as a whole, take their stand as men and as Protestant ministers, "without fear and without reproach." The Jew-Papal combine that is flooding the land with anti-Protestant propaganda in movie picture form would back up mighty quick, if the Protestant ministers, as a whole, were real men.

At Walla Walla the Black Pope has a pair of priests working in the guise of Protestant ministers. They are quite prominent—distastefully so. They are in favor of anything that is Roman Catholic. One of the pair was absent from the Ministerial Union meeting, and "the Union," seizing its opportunity, took a strong stand against the vicious and outrageous film.

We have advised that the day is coming soon when every Protestant pulpit in Walla Walla will be occupied by a Protestant minister.

Playing Part of Cowards.

In Walla Walla the Klansmen are active church members, and they are trying to encourage the lazy Protestant clergy to stand up like men and fight for their own good name. Many pews are empty because of the preacher's cowardly attitude on Protestantism. Some of them frantically resort to newspaper advertising, and some adopt secular subjects, in a vain effort to attract an audience. They are cowards of the white-livered kind, so common throughout the country among the Protestant hoists, and are "afraid of stirring up strife," and so they preach on silly current topics—Coulism, for instance. Then they attend functions of the black-robed Knights of Columbus, and sit grinningly upon the platform at K. C. lectures, brazen as Punch, and then they pretend to wonder why their pews are empty, and why they are detested and despised by all true Protestants.

Charlie Has Their Number.

Charlie Chaplin, the war slacker, has their number. The slow-footed little foreigner has them sized up. He knows that he can spit in the face of the average Protestant preacher and make him like the spit. He was about to shoot his abominable filth and insults in the faces of the Walla Walla people, when the Klansmen said NO! And the Ministerial Union, with its strongest K. C. member absent—probably on some other duty assigned by the Black Pope—did itself proud, for the first time, and sent a delegation to the wet Mayor and a resolution to the manager of the Arcade. The offensive photoplay was cancelled. The

real Protestant preachers of Walla Walla are to be congratulated. Finally, at last, the Walla Walla ministers seem to be arousing from their cowardly lethargy. They have been smothered with insult and ridicule for so long that even the ever-charitable Klansmen had come to look upon them as hopeless and utterly contemptible.

Must Cease to Be Cowards.

The Kike-Catholic movie producers will change their tactics with reference to the Protestant pulpit only when the Protestant preachers as a whole indicate that they have self-respect enough to demand a reform.

Every Klan and every Protestant preacher in America should denounce "The Pilgrim" and chase Chaplin and all his works out of the country, just as he and "Doug" Fairbanks were chased out of Mexico by the outraged people. The Mexicans are making their country too hot for the Kike-Catholic disturbers.

Every Klan ought to offer a reward for the discovery of any movie play which ridicules the Catholic hierarchy or the Catholic "bachelor" priests, or the Jew rabbi. The Kikes and Catholics own and control the entire movie industry. There is a nation-wide coalition between them, in everything. Look at Chicago, and its horrible vice conditions, recently exposed by the publication of facts which stank rank in the nostrils of the people, facts that ought to rouse the fighting blood of every American worthy of the name—the Koon-Kike-Catholic combination, through which a horde of young white girls—all born Protestants—are held in slavery by nigger "papas" employed by the overruling combination. This reference is by the way.

All Honor to Klansmen.

In all the movie productions the Romish and Jewish churches are shown in a dignified and reverent way, and the Protestant church and its preachers in a contemptuous and ridiculous way. We aren't defending them; they aren't worth defending, nor worthy of it, as a whole, but are simply telling the facts. It would seem that the Knights of Columbus and the Catholic Welfare Council have a contract with the movie producers and their players. There's evidence of it.

All honor to Walla Walla Klan No. 3, which is constantly on the lookout for such photoplays as "The Pilgrim." The movie man who brings one of that kind to Walla Walla is promised a warm time—a hot reception—and a quick getaway.

WALLA WALLA, WASH., March 28.—"The Pilgrim," by Charlie Chaplin, will be at the Arcade this week. The "preacher" is the richest of all fun subjects. Chaplin in this film excels himself in rich ridicule, as an escaped convict in the pulpit. There are films and films in which progress is shown in the development of pulpit ridicule, but no movie star ever has approached this "masterly stroke." It is one loud, continuous scream; but it is not entirely minus educational value. The producer has omitted all reference to the Cross, the crucifix, the Virgin Mary, the candles, and all idols and other altar equipment, so that we can agree that "The Pilgrim" is too funny to be sacrilegious. It teaches us not to take the Protestant pulpit too seriously.

This picture has the moral support and sanction of the press, the pulpit and public officials, and no possible harm can result from it. It proves how craven and submissive to insult the clergy are. There is a real demand for this picture, and there is no opposition which is entitled to notice. Much may be learned by a portrayal of clowns, clergy and criminals in a single act.

FUGITIVE "FATHER" GRACE NOW WANTED BY FEDERAL COURT

Denver Den Seems to Be Consuming Big Quantities of Booze.

WASHINGTON, D. C., March 28.—Federal officials here are preparing to start a rigid inquiry into the case of the "Rev. Father" Walter A. Grace, a Catholic priest, of Denver, Colo., who is said to have disappeared, following receipt of news that officers were seeking him on a charge of forging the name of the mother superior to a flock of liquor permits.

Grace is said to have signed the name of "Sister" Germaine, superior of the Mullen home for the aged, near Denver, to an application for five barrels of whiskey. It is further charged that he signed the name of the mother superior to express receipts for the whiskey and that he got ten barrels from her the same way last year.

The question that arises here is how the mother superior comes by so much booze and what she does with it. Officials here say they have no record of how she could use such a large amount of liquor personally, or ever feed it out to the rest of the nuns in her charge. Wherefore an inquiry is to be made.

It was asserted in Denver, it is understood here, that the priest would be able to "explain satisfactorily" the whole transaction, but officials intimate that the "satisfactory" end of it will come in with who does the listening.

It also seems that the mother superior is going to have to do some wild explaining in order to convince the prohibition officials that she had a right to all that booze.
