

LAW OF SECRECY SHALL BE OBEYED: KEEP VISORS DOWN

Base Treason to Reveal Identity of Fellow-Member of the Klan.

One of the first duties of a Klansman is to obey the rules and regulations of this great American order of which we are so justly proud.

At the head of the list of the laws of the Klan stands that of absolute secrecy.

This law is being violated by some Klansmen, possibly with the best and most patriotic of intentions. Reports come to the Imperial Palace of parades of Klansmen with their visors raised and of Klansmen freely admitting their membership to aliens and, worse still, divulging the membership of others.

Strict Secrecy Necessary.

The effectiveness of the work of this secret and patriotic organization is hampered in its effectiveness by the lifting of the visor and the revelation of identity. The enemies of the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan want nothing better than to have the identity of its members positively known so that they may plan their assaults definitely and individually. All their efforts are to this end.

By raising your visor as a Klansman you are acting unfairly to your fellow Klansmen. The enemy is organized, watchful, resourceful and intelligent. Once you are known as a Klansman your friends and associates are under suspicion and marked down for boycott or worse. If for no other reason than this, guard your membership with care.

Thousands of Klansmen stand ready of course to tell the world they are members and proud of it. But they are Klansmen for a definite purpose—because they have special work to do. If they reveal their identity their efforts for Americanism, the establishment of better morals, the enforcement of laws through properly constituted authorities, are handicapped from the very beginning.

The wrongdoer at present never knows when the eye of a Klansman is upon him.

Men in high public office who are remiss in the trust imposed upon them are at present unable to tell from which direction or at what hour action may come in the cause of better government.

To expose your identity as a Klansman lessens your ability to perform constructive work for your country and your community.

Wonders Never Cease

We are living in the age of wonders. When ten years ago folks would scoff at a new idea and say, "impossible," they now consider it seriously and admit, "Well, that might be done. Nothing is really impossible."

Especially does this seem true of the wireless. The latest discovered use of the wireless is its ability to make the deaf hear. Many people who have never heard any sound, have listened to music and the human voice for the first time in their lives, because the ear drums were affected by the finer vibrations of wireless when the ordinary tuning for vibration made no impression.

In a most remarkable book, "A Dweller on Two Planets," dedicated by Phyllos, one who has lived on this earth 12,000 years ago, through the medium of automatic writing, we learn that wireless was developed beyond our present conception by a civilization far superior to the generation of our day. INTENSIVE DRIVE FOR NEW MEMBERS

The Realms of Maryland and Delaware have united in an intensive drive to further Klankraft and increase the membership of the Klan.

On May 28, hundreds of fiery crosses were lighted on hill tops in the two States at 9 P. M. This signified the opening of the campaign which will align thousands of Protestant Americans beneath the starry flag and fiery cross. At the recent meeting at Baltimore it was planned to double the membership of the Klan in Maryland and Delaware during the coming three months.

MAYOR REFUSES TO ACCEPT BIG OFFER

Public Auditorium Needed but Klan's Building Plan Is Rejected.

LITTLE ROCK, Ark., June 7.—Members of the city council here have decided to report unfavorably on the offer of the Little Rock Klan to erect a public auditorium in the city park. Mayor Brickhouse is not in sympathy with the Klan project for the reason that he feels it might create strife in the community. He says there are other organizations antagonistic to the Klan whose membership would never attend functions in the building. Many foreign-born persons, Knights of Columbus and Jews would not co-operate.

The Klan has promised a fine building seating 7500 persons and costing not less than \$50,000. The only provision was that the city should lease the building site for 50 years and give the Klan permission to hold its meetings there. When completed, the building would have been given absolutely to the city.

This move proves to the people of Little Rock that the Catholics and Jews have been bluffing all along in their vaunted patriotism and their alleged aspirations to establish good will and tolerance. Their very intolerance toward any move made by the Klan, good or bad, has convinced people here that their only concern is in trying to stamp out something of which they do not approve.

TWO INVISIBLE EMPIRES.

There be two invisible Empires in the world of men: one is the Order of the Ku Klux Klan—here yesterday, today and forever—devoted to pure and uncompromising Americanism; the other the empire of the Papal Hierarchy, in which the Pope of Rome claims spiritual and political power supreme over the human race.
