Useful in Politics

Although Colonel North deprecates political ambition, and admits only a desire to be as useful as possible to his fellow-man, this being his only measure of worth, he was elected and served as Republican presidential elector from Oregon in 1912, and also served as a member of the Lower House during the 1921 regular and special sessions of the State Legislature. He made a record for wise legislation and uncommon efficiency.
