The Strike is Declared Off.

Wilkesbarre, Pa., Oct. 21.—The mine workers' convention has accepted the arbitration proposition, declared the strike off and agreed to return to work on Thursday morning, next. The resolution was adopted at 11:55. The vote was unanimous. It was decided that all members to place the mines in condition can return to work at once. Convention adjourned sine die.

Washington, Oct. 21.—President Roosevelt has summoned the Strike Arbitration Commission to meet here Friday at 10 A. M.

New York, Oct. 21.—A bill will be introduced in the next Legislature looking to the incorporation of labor unions, says a Boston dispatch to the Tribune. The movement is an outgrowth of the coal strike.

Col. Jeff Myers, a prominent attorney of Portland, arrived at Marshfield, overland, Saturday, to take a look at the Coos Bay section, and also of the coast country as far south as Crescent City.

A telephone message received in town Sunday, from Parkersburg, was to the effect that Geo. Majory had died that day from injuries received the day previous. He was working in Jenkin's camp, back of Randolph, and was struck on the head by a falling limb.

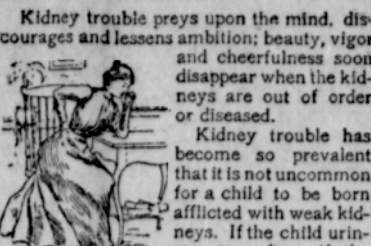
