TRACT WILL BE
PLATTED INTO LOTS

Portland Real Estate Firm
To Exploit the New
Property

A company composed of Guy E. Dobson, G. M. Slocum, J. A. Norwood, J. A. Wilcox, Chad Irwin, J. Howard Leist and Mr. Meith, all of Redmond, last week bought 80 acres of valuable property adjoining the original townsite of Redmond on the west. The consideration was \$20,000.

The property will be platted and placed on the market at an early date.

Williams & Kanzler, a well known Portland real estate firm, have entered into a contract with the company and been appointed selling agents. They will establish offices in Seattle and Spokane to give the exploitation of the property widespread publicity through newspaper advertising and otherwise. It is stated the above firm will establish an office here to handle the property of the Redmond Townsite Co. and also exploit this property through their other offices.

It is understood that a club is being organized in Redmond to take over 8 or 10 acres in the tract to be used for club house purposes, build an artificial lake, lay out tennis courts, a ball park etc.

Killed By a Falling Tree

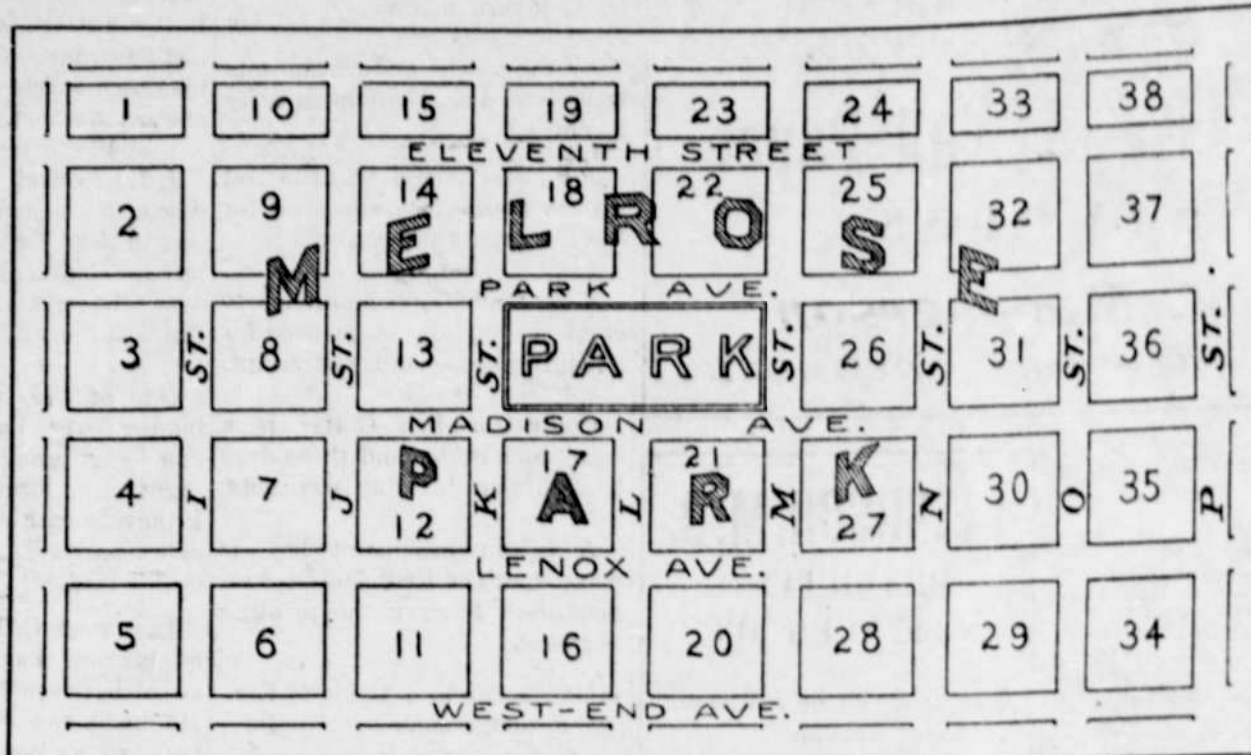
