Votes for the young lady the honor will be conferred on will be one cent each, and the one receiving the largest number of votes will be tendered the position. The voting contest will be open June 7th at Butler's drug store, and close Saturday, June 28th, at 8 p. m. The money received from the votes will be used to decorate the float.

FARMERS WANT STATE EXPERIMENT STATIONS

Madras Pioneer: Do the people of Crook county want State Agricultural Experiment stations located in their county, or do they not?

Are the taxpayers of Crook county willing to pay for the partial maintenance of same?

These are questions that would seem to be of vital importance to not only the farmers but to every person interested in the development of the county's resources.

N. P. Poulsen, president of the Crook County Farmers' Union, has interested himself in the matter to a considerable extent.

He is anxious to see two experiment stations in operation, one at Metolius and one at Redmond, one in the dry farming district and one in the irrigated district.

The state of Oregon stands ready to donate \$2500 to the cause if the county will raise a like amount. It is estimated that \$5000 will defray the expenses of the two stations for a season.

Mr. Poulsen is anxious to hear from the farmers on the matter and if there is strong enough sentiment in favor of the maintenance of the stations a petition will be presented to the county court, asking that the necessary appropriation be made.
