WATER RATE COMPARISONS

DATA GIVEN ON WATER RATES
CHARGED IN DIFFERENT
CITIES IN OREGON, WASHING-
TON AND IDAHO, COMPARED
WITH REDMOND RATE.

Much has been said about the water rates charged by the City of Redmond, and it is understood that next year a meter system will be installed by the city.

The claim has been made by some that the price charged by the city for water, \$1.50 per month for dwellings, one tap, without bath or toilet, is too high. City officials in a position to know state the above price is none to high and the city is compelled to make this charge in order to meet running expenses of the plant and pay interest on the bonds. Below is published water rates charged in different cities in Oregon, Washington and Idaho:

Portland
Municipally Owned Plant.
Family of 10 persons or less, per month 50c
Bath tub, per month 10c
Water closet, per month 15c
Total 75c

The Dalles
Municipally Owned Plant.
Family of five persons or less per month \$1.50
Each additional person per mo. .15
Also has a meter rate of 30c per 1000 gallons.
Is providing a sinking fund.

Baker City
Municipally Owned Plant.
Residence of five rooms or less, bath closets, etc. included, per month 50c
Each additional room, per mo. .10c
Meter rates per 1000 gallons .10c
Plant nets \$8,000 annually.

Pendleton
Municipally Owned Plant.
On meter system, 4000 gallons per month \$1.25
Each additional 1000 gallons, per month25

Ashland
Municipally Owned Plant.
Family, all domestic purposes, \$1.00
Bath tub10
Water closet10

Eugene
Municipally Owned Plant.
Meter system, 1000 gals. per mo. 20c
Four thousand gallons per month is a liberal supply for any average family, this being about four barrels per day.

Over in the state of Washington conditions are about the same. Here are a few from that state:

Seattle
Municipally Owned Plant.
Family of eight persons or less, per month 65c
Water closet 20c

Spokane
Municipally Owned Plant.
Dwelling, 4 rooms, per month. 80c
Each additional room 10c
Bath tub 20c
Water closet 20c

Tacoma
Municipally Owned Plant.
Residence, 5 rooms, per month \$1.25
Each additional room10

Aberdeen
Municipally Owned Plant.
Residence with bath and toilet \$1.50
Plant is netting over all operating expenses \$55,000 annually.

Bellingham
Has two water systems, one supplying what was formerly the town of Whatcom, being the larger and municipally owned, while the former city of Fairhaven, which is now part of the city of Bellingham, has a private owned system. The rates of the municipally owned plant are given as
Minimum rate 50c
Bath tubs 25c
Water closet 25c

Olympia
Privately Owned
Dwelling, 6 rooms, per month, \$1.00
Each additional room10
Bath tub25
Water closet25

Centralia, Chehalis and Tenino are all supplied by the Washington-Oregon corporation.
Dwelling, not more than 5 rooms or 5 persons \$1.00
Each person or room over 5 . . . 10
Water closets25
Lavatory25
Bath tub25
This would make a 5 room house with 5 persons \$1.75
A 6 room house with 6 persons. 1.95

Base rate, per month \$1.00
This allows 4000 gallons per mo.
Each additional 1000 gallons. .20c
