On Redmond's east side, riders will find the Radlands trailhead at the end of NE Negus Way near the High Desert Sports complex.

Smith Rock State Park, located just 15 minutes north of Redmond, has trails that circumnavigate the park and highlight its sheer cliffs and the climbers ascending them. Families and those looking for a leisurely ride head to the Smith Rock State Park Loop, while cyclists in search of a legburning workout ride the challenging, 11mile Burma Road Loop.
