Assistance League of Bend provides new clothing to 700 students

From a press release

Through its Operation School Bell program, Assistance League of Bend is providing new clothing to more than 700 students in kindergarten through grade 12 in Redmond and Bend.

Like the fall clothing campaign, students will shop for new school clothes at the Redmond and Bend Walmart stores on designated shopping days in February and March, according to a press release.

The high school and middle school students will shop for new school clothes using \$100 vouchers and the elementary students will shop for new school clothes using \$80 vouchers provided by Assistance League of Bend.

The vouchers are distributed to students in need by the Family Access Network advocates at each school. Assistance League of Bend

has modified the shopping events to help keep the students and volunteers safe and they are excited to be able to support students in person again this winter.

Assistance League of Bend continues to see a rising need to provide local children with basic clothing items. One in five local children live in poverty. In addition to meeting essential clothing needs, Assistance League of Bend has found that new clothes elevate a child's self-esteem, help them feel more accepted by their peers, and empower them to learn. Children with better self-esteem are more likely to complete their education, breaking the cycle of poverty.

Temperatures continue upward trend at airport

From the National Weather Service

According to preliminary data received by NOAA's National Weather Service in Pendleton, temperatures at Redmond airport averaged slightly warmer than normal during the month of February 2022.

The average temperature was 36.9 degrees which was 0.3 degrees warmer than the normal average temperature for this month. High temperatures averaged 53.0 degrees with the high of 74 degrees being recorded on Feb. 10. Low temperatures averaged 20.9 degrees with the low of -6 degrees

being recorded on Feb. 23.

There were 26 days when the low temperature was below 32 degrees and 1 day with a low temperature below 0 degrees. Redmond airport also reported 3 days when the high temperature was less than 32 degrees.

Precipitation was much below normal during February, totaling 0.01 inches, which was 0.65 inches below normal. Precipitation of at least .01 inch was reported on 0 days. The heaviest amount of precipitation was 0.01 inches, which was reported on Feb. 26.
