K Bar D, located at 3220 Northwest Way, is an elite Black Angus cattle ranch that raises show cattle, performance bulls, genetic offerings and beef.

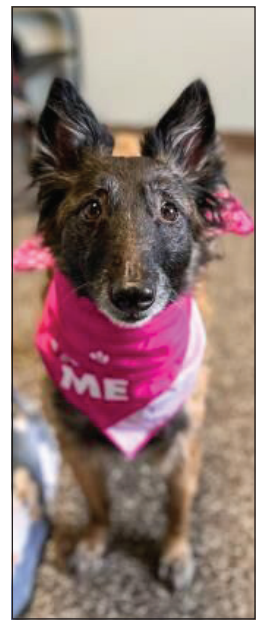
PET OF THE WEEK

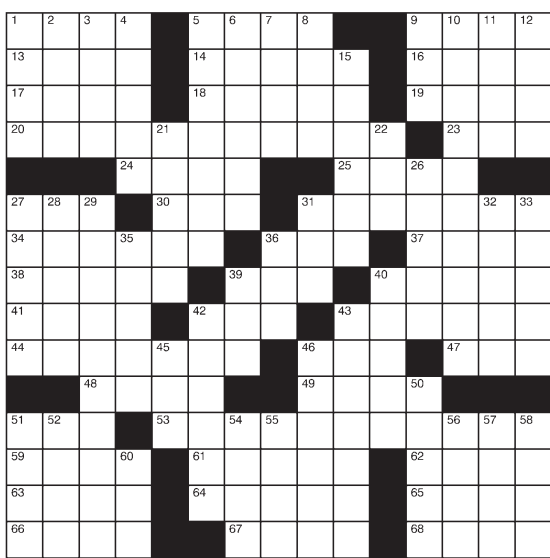

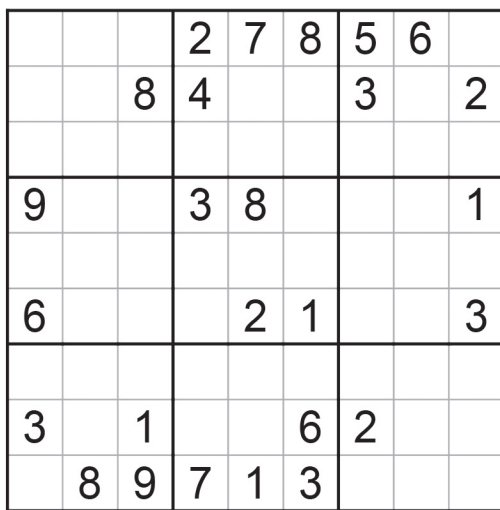
