### Debris burning ends June 1 in Redmond Fire and Rescue District

Redmond Fire & Rescue, in conjunction with the Central Oregon Fire Chiefs Association, has announced a closure of outdoor debris burning in the area. Starting Wednesday, June 1, debris burning will be banned for the rest of fire season. Backyard fires that include warming fires, campfires and cooking fires are typically allowed year-round in the Redmond area, when used within the guidelines set forth in local burning regulations. Additional restrictions on campfires can be placed during the hottest parts of summer

to further reduce the risk of wildfire.

Check restrictions each time you burn by calling the burn information line at 541-504-5035.

As a reminder for everyone living in Central Oregon, be sure your home has defensible space around it to help protect it from potential wildfire. ### Spray feature open at Centennial Park

The spray features at Redmond's Centennial Park officially opened for the season

Friday, May 27 and will operate every day from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. through Labor Day.

The city of Redmond partnered with the Redmond Area Parks and Recreation District to operate the kiosk at Centennial Park.

This kiosk will offer basic snacks such as ice cream, water and soda.

City crews are also working to turn on all park drinking fountains. They have completed the fountains in the Dry Canyon and are scheduled to have the remaining park fountains running by Memorial Day.

The state said in a press release that it would waive day-use parking fees and camping fees for all tent, RV and horse campsites for the occasion celebrating the 100-year anniversary of Oregon's state parks.

The 26 locations with waived fees include Central Oregon's Tumalo State Park, La Pine State Park, Smith Rock State Park and The Cove Palisades State Park.

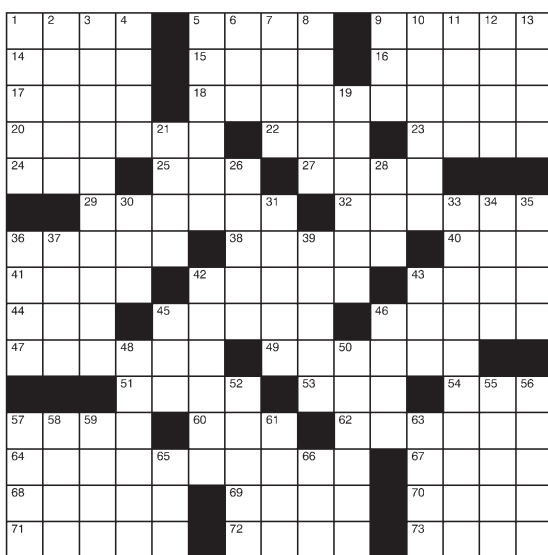
