#### **Debris burning ends June** 1 in Redmond Fire and **Rescue District**

Redmond Fire & Rescue, in conjunction with the Central Oregon Fire Chiefs Association, has announced a closure of outdoor debris burning in the area. Starting Wednesday, June 1, debris burning will be banned

for the rest of fire season. Backvard fires that include warming fires, campfires and cooking fires are typically allowed year-round in the Redmond area, when used within the guidelines set forth in local burning regulations. Additional restrictions on campfires can be placed during

to further reduce the risk of wildfire.

Check restrictions each time you burn by calling the burn information line at 541-504-5035.

As a reminder for everyone living in Central Oregon, be sure your home has defensible space around it to help protect it from potential wildfire. More information about creating defensible space and preparing for fire season can be found at www.projectwildfire.org.




