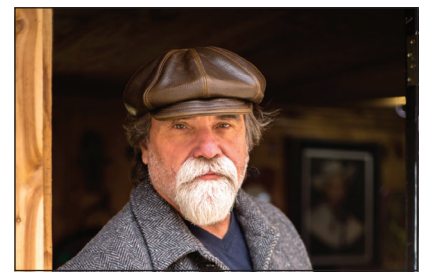
by many artists) or The Chicks' "Long Time Gone."

Hour concert series.

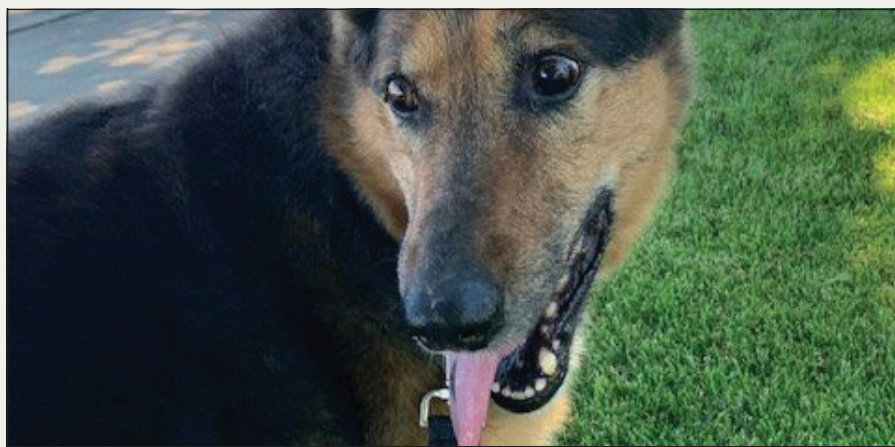
