Since 1985, NeighborImpact has led the region in bringing resources and solutions to poverty in Crook, Deschutes and Jefferson counties and the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs. We help meet residents' basic needs, build economic security and create a community where everyone thrives. Our administrative offices and food warehouse are located at 2303 SW First Street.

In 2021, we touched more than 500,000 lives through our services.

Every day, to meet the need in Redmond, we provide:

- **-Food** Distributed at 5 emergency food sites & through one Mobile Food Pantry
- **-Energy bill assistance** for home heating & cooling expenses
- **-Rental assistance**, eviction prevention, street outreach, short-term housing & homeless winter shelter
- **-Early childhood education** + linkages to other services for children 0-5 & pregnant women; 7 classrooms in Redmond
- **-Financial coaching & counseling** to strengthen household finances & build homeownership
- -Child Care provider training, technical assistance & business support
- -Construction services, insulation, heating systems & more to weatherize homes
- **-Loans for home rehabilitation**, septic & well replacement, & down payments
- -Bill paying for persons unable to manage their bills due to illness or disability
- -Help applying for & renewing Oregon Health Plan insurance coverage
