Statement No. 1 is the people's voice in the matter of whom they wish to represent them; it is the true principle of "a government for the people and by the people" and the workings of the new state of affairs is being watched by practically every state in the union.

The country press of Oregon is openly opposed to any tampering with Statement No. 1, while the Oregonian and a few ring organs are trying to snatch it from the people.

The voters of Tillamook county will be sure vote for the man for legislator and he only who announces himself as voting for the people's choice for the seat of United States senator.
