State Fair Salem.

Linn County Fair Scio.

The Scio Stock and Agricultural Fair Association have completed arrangements for the Linn County Fair to be held in Scio Sept. 23-4-1908 and the premium lists are already in the hands of the public. Over one thousand dollars has been accumulated and offered as premiums with also two hundred dollars for special premiums.

The State Fair is to be held at Salem September 14th to 19th inclusive, and ten thousand dollars is offered in prizes for exhibits this year. As Salem is the county seat of Marion county and Stayton is eighteen miles distant to the southeast our exhibits will be displayed at the State Fair as it takes the place of a county fair with the exception that every county in the state of Oregon may compete.

The state assists each county in the holding of annual fairs and through this channel the products of farms, fields, gardens, orchards, forests, hills and dales can be displayed advantageously resulting in the stimulating of friendly rivalry between energetic exhibitors.

Stayton and vicinity will be well represented at the State Fair and why can we not have a day at the State Fair as well as at Scio. By the time the fairs open dirt will be flying on the Portland-Salem-Stayton electric line between Salem and this point and it is fully in keeping with our progressive spirit that our citizens have a day at the State Fair this year.
