These questions have been asked of local exemption boards time and again since the sending out of the questionnaires began. The answer to the first question is "No." The answer to the second question is "Yes." An alien of draft age who has not declared his intention to become a citizen of the United States may waive exemption on Services 2nd 4th and 5th Sun- the ground of alienage, but if he does not want to waive his exemption, the local board has no choice but to put him in Class V. However, he must answer his questionnaire and return it within the seven-day limit to his local ments for loaning eastern money. zen must do, or he will endanger his right to be placed in Class V.
