Sheriff's Notice of Sale of Real Property on Foreclosure.

Notice is hereby given, that by virtue of an execution duly issued out of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Marion, and to me directed on the 8th day of April, 1919, upon a judgment and decree duly rendered, entered of record and docketed in and by said court, on the 12th day of March, 1919, in a certain suit then in said Court pending, wherein W. C. Christensen, was plaintiff and Carry Riggs and G. R. Riggs, her husband, S. C. Bass and Sarah A. Bass, his wife, P. J.
