

SHOT 9 TIMES SOLDIER TAKES HUN TRENCHES

Corporal Storms Heights of Ourcq River With Remnants of His Platoon

At the direction of the War Depart-ment General Pershing has forwarded from France accounts of 100 deeds of hereism performed by soldiers of the American forces, most typical of the spirit of our army. The story of Corporal Sidney Manning is one of conspicuous gallantry.

Corporal Manning was in charge of an automatic rifle squad when his battalion assaulted the heights of the Ourcq River. During the advance on the hill Manning's platoon commander was killed, and just as the line reached the crest of the hill the platoon sergeant fell.

Corporal Manning then assumed command of the platoon. Though he himself was severely wounded and was the only survivor of his squad, this seldier led forward the 35 remaining men of the platoon against an enemy strong point, wired, entrenched and defended by machine guns, which dominated the Ourcq valley. He was re-peatedly wounded but with seven men took the position. While his men consolidated the line he held off a considerable number of the enemy fifty yards away with his rifle. When the posttion had been consolidated he crawled back to shelter, having received nine
