

#### Rent Profiteers in Manila

Londlords owners of residences and business buildings in Manila. are taking advantage of 'the paucity of homes and commercial structures to raise rents abnormally, Workers for salaries or wages, and firms and companies in mercantile pursuits, com plain bitterly of the demands of the owners or lessors of houses and stores factories and bodegas. Most of the victims have to yield to the increased rents because they have no recourse, One man who paid \$40 a month for his small, uncomfortable home, has heen informed that he must pay \$50,-Manila Times.

#### 1918 Cotton Worth \$2,067,000,000.

The 1918 cotton crop, lint and seed. was worth \$2,067,000,000 to the producers. This is about three times the value of the cotton crop of 1914 and is twice the value of the crop of 1913, which had the highest value of record. The computation has just been made, at the close of the cotton year, riculture, bureau of crop estimates. marketings .- Agricultural Department News Letter.


