

Volunteers sought for city committees

The City of Keizer is currently looking for volunteers to fill vacancies on several city committees.

Applications must be received by noon on Wednesday, Jan. 7, to be considered at the Jan. 15 Volunteer Coordinating Committee meeting.

The current openings include:

- **Arts Commission** – This Commission reviews, evaluates, selects, maintains and documents all artwork, public art and public murals within the city. The commission may advise the city council and city manager on the management, execution, installation, or placement of the artwork, public art and public murals and will recommend guidelines for adoption by the city council for the selection and placement of the artwork giving preference to Oregon artists. The commission meets on the fourth Tuesday of every month at 6 p.m. (one vacancy)

- **Budget committee** – Responsibilities include assisting the city council in the examination and analyzing of proposed budgets for the city of Keizer. The budget committee meets in May of each year to review the annual budget. (one vacancy)

- **Traffic Safety/Bikeways Pedestrian committee** – This committee is responsible for reviewing traffic safety issues in Keizer and making recommendations to the city council for

improvements. Members also make recommendations for future locations of bike lanes in the city and work to promote bicycle safety and use throughout the community. In addition to the monthly committee meeting, there may be other events which require extra volunteer hours. The committee meets on the fourth Thursday of each month at 6 p.m. at City Hall. (one vacancy)

- **Stormwater Advisory committee** – Members of this committee review guidelines and make recommendations to the city council on the development of ordinances pertaining to illicit discharge detection and elimination, stormwater runoff control and stormwater management. The committee is seeking applicants who have experience in the development or building industry; however it is not a requirement. Meetings for this committee are scheduled as needed and are usually held from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. (one vacancy)

Church beginning in-depth Bible study

Countryside Christian Church is launching a 31-week series on Biblical literacy beginning with its services Sunday, Jan. 4.

Thompson will be delivering sermons based on *The Story*, by Max Lucado and Randy Frazee, in an effort to increase Biblical literacy and help readers understand God's story from Genesis to Revelation and how their own stories intersect with God's.

Consisting of 31 chapters with scriptures sequenced in chronological order, *The Story* presents the stories of the Bible in a novel-like read.

The text provides curricu-

lums for children, teens and

adults. Thompson is inviting anyone with an interest in a greater understanding of the Bible to join congregants for their journey through the Good Book.
