# **Keizer Iris Festival returns May 14 to 17**

In less than two months, Keizer's biggest annual event returns.

The 28th annual Keizer Iris Festival will take place Thursday, May 14 through Sunday, May 17.

Per usual, the highlight event of the weekend is the parade on Saturday sponsored by Valley Credit Services, which starts at River Road and Lockhaven Drive at 10:30 a.m. and proceeds south along River Road through town.

The main parade will be preceded by a pet parade and a fun run.

"About 30,000 to 40,000 people pack the streets for the parade," said Joe Egli, the former Keizer City Councilor who is once again serving as festival chair. "You can still put a float together."

we do is run

by our volunteers," Egli said. "This is our community hard at work. Whatever you want to do, we'll find a job for you. Tell us when you can help and what items you'd like to do."

Audrey Butler, president of the Keizer Chamber, emphasized how the event runs on volunteers.

"We need volunteers," Butler said. "We had around 200 last year."
