What to do and where to get a break in spring break

Here are some options for when the complaining starts:

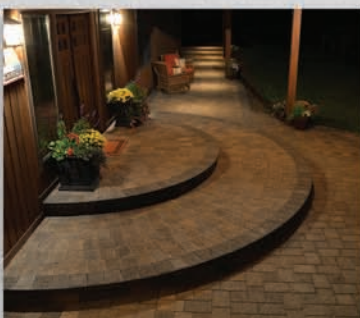
