

Gustav's sets opening date for Keizer Bargarten

The question is being asked with more and more regularity: When will Gustav's open in Keizer Station?

Originally, the new German restaurant by the McDonald's and Men's Warehouse was going to open in February. When asked for an update in February, Kyle Mallory with Koopman Ostbo told the Keizertimes the target was moved to mid-April.

Now, a more exact date for the Gustav's Bargarten has been announced.

"The scheduled opening is April 21," Mallory said last week. "As you know sometimes construction can hold up projects, but right now it looks to be April 21."

Nate Brown, director of Community Development for Keizer, hinted last week the

opening could be even sooner.

"Gustav's is applying for a temporary CO (Certificate of Occupancy) for Monday," Brown said. "They have some minor issues to correct, but they will be open probably by the end of (this) week."

Those interested in applying for a job at the new restaurant can contact general manager Jordan Walters at jordan.walters@gutenfoods.com. An interview space has been set up in a vacant office space between The Beaver Store and Famous Footwear.

Officials with the Portland-based Gustav's signed a lease last March with California-based Donahue Schriber for space on the corner of Ulali Drive and Stadium Drive. Benner Stange Associates Architects, designer of many Keizer Station buildings, was hired as architect of the new

restaurant.

The Keizer City Council approved a liquor license request in February, forwarding the request on to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission, which in turn granted approval.

Suzanne Mager, owner and president of Gustav's, said in February she was excited about Bargarten, a new concept for the company formed by her and her dad back in 1992.

"We're looking forward to unveiling Bargarten, our modern German concept, in Keizer Station," Mager said. "With a host of other exciting businesses, a baseball team nearby and a growing Salem and Keizer-area demographic, we think this new concept will give people something exciting to enjoy time and again." Last May, Mager told the

Keizertimes about the new concept being debuted in Keizer.

"My vision is something lighter, more everyday," she

said at the time. "We will still have schnitzels, sausages and fondues. The concept is a more modern, contemporary German fare. We want to

do something lighter. This is more social, more bar-centric, like you're going to a beer garden in Germany and you can see everyone."
