The fifth-inning runs scored on no hits. Steven Neff walked, Christian Lichtenhaler hit into a force out, and Amion and Compton walked. A wild pitch by reliever Brandon Hinkle scored Amion.

Attendance rose again, to 3,129.

**Sunday: Volcanoes 2, Vancouver 1**

Salem-Keizer ran its winning streak to three before

the third successive crowd of 3,000-plus.

Drew Leenhouts was the starting and winning pitcher, going seven innings with nine strikeouts. Jarret Leverett pitched an inning of relief and Eric Sim finished the game with a save.

The Canadians scored first, on a first-inning home run by Lane Thomas. The Volcanoes tied the score in the second as Miguel Gomez, who had led off with a double and gone to third base on a caught line drive by Mark Nelson, came home as Julio Pena grounded out.

In the bottom of the fourth, Shilo McCall gave the Volcanoes their final lead with a home run over the left center field wall.

Salem-Keizer made a double play in the fourth, with third baseman Chase Compton catching a line drive and throwing to John Riley at first to retire a baserunner.

John Wandling was Vancouver's starting and losing pitcher.

**Monday: Vancouver 5, Volcanoes 3**

The Volcanoes won the series three games to two but

stranded 16 baserunners in the last game despite outhitting the opposition for the first time this season.

Michael Connolly, Salem-Keizer's starting pitcher, was dominant through five innings, striking out five with one hit and no walks, but falling apart in the sixth and taking the loss. The Canadians scored four times in the sixth on three hits, a walk and a hit batsman.

The Volcanoes scored one run each in the third, fifth and eighth. Their nine hits in the game included one double apiece by Richard Amion, Chase Compton and Fernando Pujadas.

Vancouver had no stellar player, but Lane Thomas drove in three of the runs. Joey Aquino was the winning pitcher in relief and Andrew Case got his first save.

**Tuesday: Hillsboro 5, Volcanoes 4**

The lead changed twice in Salem-Keizer's first road game of the season.

It was largely a matter of runners left on base, with the Volcanoes stranding 14 and the Hops 9. Hillsboro
