**PURPOSE OF HEARING:** 

The City Council will hold a public hearing to consider proposed revisions relating to infill development standards. The revisions will incorporate many of the infill provisions that are within Section 2.316 into other applicable sections thereby eliminating the dual code aspect of the Development Code and also eliminate redundancy and sections that are in conflict with each other. The revisions to the Keizer Development Code include: Section (Infill Development Standards); 2.314 (Standards for Single Family Dwellings); (Development Standards): 2.102 (Residential Single Family); 2.103 (Limited Density Residential); 2.104 (Medium Density Residential); 2.107 (Mixed Use); 2.118 Transition); 2.302 (Urban Standards); 2.129 (Street (Chemawa Interchange Overlay); 2.303 (Off-Street Parking Loading); and (Definitions); 1.200 2.310 Standards (Development for Land Divisions); 2.311 (Planned Unit Development). The Planning Commission unanimously recommended that the proposed revisions be adopted. LAND USE DECISION


