

Events to mark 100th birthday of KHC building

The Keizer Heritage Center will celebrate the 100th anniversary of the building it calls home all year with special events through November.

The building began life as the second Keizer School and stood at the corner of River and Chemawa Roads in downtown Keizer for more than 80 years. The building was rescued, restored and relocated to its current location on Chemawa Road next to the Keizer Civic Center.

The Keizer Heritage Foundation, which owns and operates the building, will have a large contingency in the Iris Festival Parade in May.

In August the center will host a Back to School Night on Thursday, Aug. 18 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. There will be historical displays, school-themed activities. The evening will include a wine tasting.

On Saturday, Nov. 12, it will be a school reunion, open to all those attended Keizer School when it was held in the old building.

The Keizer Heritage Center is home to the Keizer Heritage Museum, which currently has a *Star Wars* display; the Keizer Art Association and its Enid Joy Mount Gallery and the Keizer Community Library.

Tacos were on the menu as the Keizer Community Dinner continued with a free dinner on Wednesday, March 30, at St. Edward Catholic Church.

The taco dinner was prepared by two Keizer Chamber of Commerce groups: Keizer Network of Women (KNOW) and Men of Action in Keizer (MAK).
