

"Over my teaching career, kids' skills and ability has gotten better so I think we've raised the bar and it's harder to do stuff with the bar raised, for sure.

"Kids are more challenging. There are a lot more distractions in kids lives now than when I started. It's not just cell phones. It's so many more things."

Behrends said he'll miss the kids and fellow teachers but not grading papers on a Sunday afternoon.

"It's been a blast, great staff, great kids. I think McNary is a great place to be and it will continue to be a great place to be.

"Society sometimes undersells kids. You shouldn't. There's great potential there."




