An attempt to sell a \$2,000 set of tires stolen from a Keizer store led to the arrest of one of the culprits Sunday, Nov. 27.

The seller agreed to meet the buyer in the Shopko parking lot on Lancaster Drive North-

Plain clothes officers arrived at the site ahead of time and waited for the seller to arrive around 10 p.m. The tires were visible in the bed of a pick-up truck.

The officers made contact with the seller, later identified as Shawn Michael Hannan, 43, of Salem. Hannan told police he and a friend, who he did not identify, had stolen the tires the previous day.

Hannan was taken to the Marion County Correctional Facility and charged with one count of theft in the first degree. His bail was set at

Two officers and a sergeant came in on their day off to assist with the arrest.
