# Online sale leads cops to thief

An attempt to sell a \$2,000 set of tires stolen from a Keizer store led to the arrest of one of the culprits Sunday, Nov. 27.

Jesus Martinez, owner of Martinez Tires at 4210 River Road N., reported that four tires were stolen from his business Saturday, Nov. 26.

The following day, a friend of Martinez spotted a set of tires he believed were the ones taken from the shop on the website www.offferupnow.com. The friend set up a time to purchase the tires Sunday evening.

The seller agreed to meet the buyer in the Shopko parking lot on Lancaster Drive Northeast.

Plain clothes officers arrived at the site ahead of time and waited for the seller to arrive around 10 p.m. The tires were visible in the bed of a pick-up truck.

The officers made contact with the seller, later identified as Shawn Michael Hannan, 43, of Salem. Hannan told police he and a friend, who he did not identify, had stolen the tires the previous day.

Hannan was taken to the Marion County Correctional Facility and charged with one count of theft in the first degree. His bail was set at \$10,000.

Two officers and a sergeant came in on their day off to assist with the arrest.

## Burglar nabbed minutes after break-in

A 23-year-old Keizer man was arrested after a suspected burglary on Cherry Avenue Northeast in the wee hours of Sunday, Nov. 27.

Officer Martin Powell responded to a business alarm at Pinnacle Physical Therapy and arrived three minutes later.

As Powell walked up to the business, he encountered a man riding a bike from the rear of the business.

Officer Eric Jefferson and Sgt. Dan Kelley soon joined Powell in the investigation. Officers determined that a shed behind the business had been broken into and a fence that surrounds the shed had been damaged.

The owner of the business arrived and told officers that a stereo system was missing from the shed. It was found under a bush a short distance away.

The man riding the bike, Christopher Cook of Keizer, was arrested and charged with second-degree burglary, possession of burglar tools and criminal mischief. He was taken to the Marion County Correctional Facility.
