Woman arrested after kicking dog, resisting officers

A Keizer woman was arrested after allegedly kicking a dog and resisting arrest after a Keizer police officer attempted to find another adult to care for her.

On Monday, Jan. 23, around 3 p.m., multiple callers

notified police that there was a woman in Ben Miller Park in south-Keizer who had been spotted kicking a dog and



was possibly intoxicated. The woman was also bleeding from the head.

Upon arrival, the officer suspected the woman was highly intoxicated and feared for her safety. The woman accepted a ride to an apartment complex on Clearview Avenue Northeast where the officer hoped to find another adult to care for her.

The officer said the woman's behavior continued to deteriorate as he tried to deescalate the situation. Eventually, he placed her under arrest for second degree animal

The woman continued to resist the arresting officer and his back-up officer, allegedly spitting, kicking as they tried to place her in back of a patrol vehicle. Once she was inside the car, the woman continued kicking and banging her head against the partition.

Tammy Lynn Carrick, 43. was taken to the Marion County Correctional Facility and charged with assaulting an officer, resisting arrest and animal abuse.

MAN ARRESTED FOR MISCHIEF, MENACING

Throwing rocks at a Keizer Police Department vehicle landed a Salem man in handcuffs Saturday, Jan. 28.

About 4 a.m., Sgt. Jeff Goodman was patrolling the area of Wheatland Road North and McNary Heights Drive north looking for a wanted person when he observed a male swaying as he walked along the road.

The man appeared younger than the subject Goodman was seeking, but suspected he was intoxicated and underage.

Goodman was following the man from his car, about 30 feet behind him, when suspect bent down and scooped up a handful of rocks. He spun around and began throwing the rocks at Goodman's patrol

Goodman exited his vehicle after hearing a rock strike his car and confronted the man who still appeared to have more rocks in his hand. Goodman ordered the man to drop the rocks, but he did not comply, KPD officials said.

The man drew his arm back in a throwing motion and Goodman fired his Taser striking the suspect.

Tyler Austin Longacre, 20, of Salem, was arrested and charged with attempted criminal mischief and menacing. He was also issued a citation for being a minor in possession of alcohol.




