

# Lady Celts get first win

McNary's girls tennis team earned its first win of the season on Tuesday, April 4.

Playing at Courthouse in Salem, the Lady Celts won two matches in third set tiebreakers to defeat McKay 6-1.

McNary senior Dianna Cervantes lost her first set, 3-6, at No. 3 singles, but came back to win the second set 7-6 and then the tiebreaker.

At 2 doubles, sophomores Sofia Zielinski and Natalie Gonzalez also dropped their first set, 2-6, before storming back to take the second 7-5 and win the tiebreaker.

McNary senior Mireille

Martinez and sophomore Taylor Walker easily won their first set, 6-2, at 1 doubles and were able to hold on to capture the second, 7-6.

The No. 1 singles match was never in doubt as McNary junior Hannah Childress dominated 6-0, 6-0. Junior Katherine Perez also won in straight sets at 2 singles, 6-4, 6-0.

The Lady Celts final point came at 3 doubles, where sophomores Lilia Hawes and McKenna Sieg won 6-3, 6-0.

Clarissa Giron won McKay's only match, 6-0, 6-3, at No. 4 singles.

Tied 6-3, 3-6, McNary junior Joyce Yu and sophomore

Trisha Tan weren't able to finish at 4 doubles due to time constraints with the tennis facility.

The Lady Celts also battled against Sprague on Thursday, April 6 before falling 7-1 at home.

Childress scored McNary's only point, winning 6-1, 6-1 at No. 1 singles.

Two singles matches went into three sets. Perez won the first set 7-6 before losing 3-6 and 0-6.

Cervantes dropped her first set 6-0 but came back to win the second 7-5 before falling in the third 4-6.

McNary's boys tennis team failed to get its first victory of

the season last week.

After losing to McKay 8-0 on Tuesday, the Celts fell at Sprague 7-1 on Thursday.

While McNary didn't win more than two games in a set against McKay, the Celts showed more fight versus Sprague.

Sophomore Alfredo Villarreal won 7-5, 6-4 at No. 3 singles.

At 1 singles, Carlos Flores was able to win the second set 6-0 to force a third but came up short of taking the match.

The tennis teams are back in action on Tuesday, April 18. The girls travel to West Albany while the boys host the Bulldogs at 4 p.m.

But Jonah Geist was caught looking at strike three and the game went into extra innings.

West Albany singled to start the eighth and got a runner to third base but Geist, pitching in relief, was able to get a ground ball to first base to end the threat.

Brendan Frizelle walked to lead off the bottom of the eighth and advanced to second on a wild pitch. With first base open, the Bulldogs chose to intentionally walk Ismay. After both Frizelle and Ismay advanced to third and second on a passed ball, Riley Hays

was also intentionally walked, loading the bases for Gilbert with one out.

After falling behind 0-2, Gilbert fouled off a pitch and took foul balls to earn the walk and score Frizelle from third to win the game.

"I took the first one, which I should've hit and then I was in my head a little bit and took that second one," Gilbert said. "I didn't really like it. I thought it was outside but it definitely painted the black. It was a good pitch for him. I kept my eye on the ball and made sure I didn't swing at anything that wasn't actually a strike. Holding up on that 3-2 pitch was really hard."

Hays threw the first six innings for McNary, allow-

ing three earned runs. The defense, which finished with four errors, didn't do him any favors.

"Our defense, we didn't start very well," Keeker said. "I was questioning whether we were really ready to play because we'd been pretty good defensively all year long and now we've had two games in a row where defensively we put ourselves in a hole and our backs were against the wall to start the game."

Carl Rumbaugh and Geist got the final six outs for the Celts, who evened the series with West Albany, after falling on the road 5-4 the night before.

"I didn't want to repeat last night," Gilbert said.
