

Arrest made in CCMS bomb threat

A bomb threat a student hoped would get her out of class early ended up getting her arrested.

On Wednesday, April 5, School Resource Officer Jay Prall received information about a note stating a bomb would be going off at Claggett Creek Middle School sometime in the next 24 hours.

Prall was able to identify the student and placed her under arrest for disorderly conduct.

Lt. Andrew Copeland said the student did not have any explosives or means to manufacture them. She told officers that the note was written in an attempt to get out of class early.

MAN TRIES TO HIDE AFTER DUII STOP

A 65-year-old man was arrested and charged with driving under the influence of intoxicants, attempting to elude an officer on foot and resisting arrest stemming from an incident Thursday, April 6.

After an anonymous tip about an intoxicated driver, a

Keizer officer stopped a suspect driving on Garden Court Northeast. The driver pulled into a driveway and refused officer instructions to stop moving after he exited the vehicle. The officer even tried grabbing the man's arm.

The suspect continued to walk away and entered the home before eventually returning under his own initiative. After a brief struggle, Douglas V. Johnson was taken into custody and transported to the Marion County Correctional Facility.

No one was injured.
