The Salem-Keizer School District Center for Technical Education is offering the following summer camp programs for middle school and high school students:

- Health services is from July 17 to July 28 for high school students, and from July 24 to July 28 for middle

school students. The health services summer camp will focus on hands-on skills and experiences where students can learn about health care careers.

- Fire science and EMT is from July 24 to Aug. 4 for high school students, and from July 31 to Aug. 4 for middle school students. Students will explore career fields of EMT and firefighter in a skills-based, hands-on, team-oriented approach.

- Design and create is from July 10 to July 21 for high school students, and from July 17 to July 21 for middle school students. Students will design and create a sterling engine (high school) or simple stool (middle school). High school students will work with the CTEC Manufacturing equipment.

- Automotive – "Know
