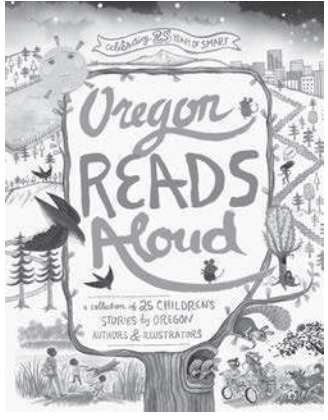

Also recommended: *East of Eden* by John Steinbeck and *Confederacy of Dunces* by John Kennedy Toole

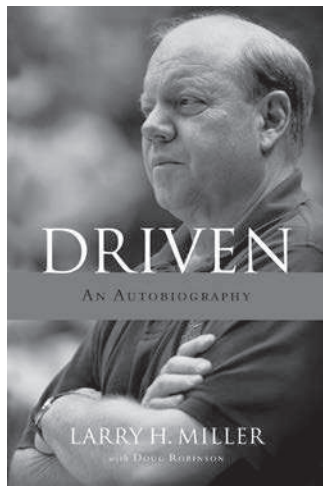
AMY KERR McVEY, Keizer's Junior Miss, America's Junior Miss 2006
