Teen arrested for robbery after altercation

A 16-year-old girl ended up charged with third degree robbery after a shoplifting attempt resulted in an altercation with a loss prevention officer (LPO).

Keizer police were called to Goodwill, 3840 River Road N., on the report of a fight about 1:30 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 27.

Upon arrival, officers learned the girl was attempting to leave the store with unpaid-for merchandise when she was confronted by a LPO. The LPO told the female she was under arrest and grabbed onto her arm. The female resisted arrest by fighting and attempting to trip the LPO.

A friend of the girl also grabbed the LPO in an attempt to pull him away from the suspect. Once police sirens were heard, the suspect stopped fighting the LPO and was cooperative.

No one was injured. Because the girl fought with the LPO, she is charged with robbery rather than theft.

Limit exposure, drink lots of water during heavy smoke

Fires in the Cascade mountain range have sent smoke into Marion County with more likely in the coming days and weeks until the flames are brought under control.

In the midst of Oregon's continuing fires and the increasing safety concerns of the smoke that results from it, the Oregon Health Authority recommends limiting exposure to the smoke as much as possible. According to their website, "Wildfire smoke is a mixture of gases and fine particles from burning trees and other plant material," which can be dangerous if inhaled.

Not vacuuming, reducing sources of indoor smoke like wood-burning stoves and candles, and use of high-efficiency air filters can help protect against the harmful effects of smoke.

The OHA also says that N95 respirators will provide some but not complete protection against the smoke, and standard dust and paper masks should not be relied on for protection.

While individual susceptibility to smoke-related health issues vary, the OHA warns that smoke may worsen the symptoms of those with cardiovascular and respiratory diseases, and provides a higher risk towards infants, children, pregnant women, and persons



over 65 years of age. Personal protection decisions should be made on a "case-by-case, day-to-day basis," based on the needs of the individual.

Exposure to smoke can lead to coughing, throat irritation, headaches or dry or watery eyes. Drinking plenty of water can combat all those symptoms.

Pets and other animals will also be affected by smoke so it is recommended to reduce their exposure to smoky areas and provide them with water just as you would for a human.
