Freshman Ethan Whalen (18:39) and junior Francisco Orta (18:57) also scored for McNary as all seven varsity runners finished under 19 minutes for the first time this season.

Running in the junior varsity race, freshman Nathaniel Prout was also able to cross the finish line in under 19 minutes with a PR of 18:49, which gave Holcomb yet another reason to feel optimistic about next season.

The Titans took advantage of a McNary fumble to score a 1-yard touchdown with 7:16 remaining.

Walling rushed for 91 yards and caught two passes for 14 yards to lead the Celtic offense.

Barker completed 12 of 26 passes for 140 yards, a touch-

down and two interceptions.

Denning rushed for 215 yards and five touchdowns for West Salem, who moved up to No. 4 in the final OSAA power rankings and will host Franklin on Friday, Nov. 3 in the first round of the state playoffs.

Despite the loss, McNary (6-3) climbed to No. 14 in the power rankings and will host No. 19 Grants Pass (6-3) on Friday.

The Celtics have to learn how to face adversity as they enter the postseason.

"Every team in the playoffs is going to be a team that deserves to be there," Auvinen said. "They're going to make plays on us. We can't just fold our tents when someone makes a play on us. We've got to rise up. We've got to come together as a group. We've got to be tougher."

"Their linebackers play close," Nagra said of Grants Pass.

"They have a three-man front. They don't blitz very much. There are some key weaknesses in the defense. They're not very big either so it's a good matchup for us."

Grants Pass is led on offense by junior quarterback Blain Hobbs, 6-foot-6-inch senior wide receiver Tayler Phillips and three senior running backs—Vincent Washington, Richie England and Teigan Jokumsen.

"They're not mind-boggling good," Auvinen said. "They do everything well. They're well coached. Their margin of victory is probably a little bit more dominant than their games are. They seem to win games by three touchdowns that are pretty close. That tells me they're making plays when they need to.

"They also do a good job of getting turnovers. They compete. I think we match up real well. I think the kids are excited for the playoffs."

McNary is hosting a playoff game for the first time since 2013 when the Celtics defeated Roseburg in the first round, which is also the last time McNary won a playoff game.

The Celtics were the 14 seed then as well.

While McNary is undefeated on the road this season, the Celtics are 1-3 at home with the only win coming against North Salem to open
