Right to Know Before You Go Act, which would provide new tools for comparing colleges and universities on measures such as total cost, likelihood of graduating and potential earnings.

On the wildfire front, Wyden and Sen. Mike (R-Idaho) Crapo have introduced the Wildfire Disaster Funding Act that would end borrowing from fire prevention funds to fight ongoing blazes and leaving prevention efforts underfunded.

On healthcare, Wyden and Sen. Orrin Hatch introduced the Keeping Kids Insurance Dependable and Secure Act that would extend funding for the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) for five years. CHIP coverage provides specific funding for functional family therapy that has been proven to cut re-arrests in half and multisystemic therapy, which has been shown to cut violent felony arrests by 75 percent.

### ON THE ESCALATING COST OF HOUSING IN OREGON AND OTHER AREAS:

"At the federal level, the government can do something about the supply. I and Sen. Maria Cantwell (D-Wash.) and Sen. Hatch have proposed expanding the low-income housing tax credit. You get more units, you reduce the pressure on costs and it helps you get more price stability. It's being supported by tenant groups and developer-type people.

I think there are a lot of other pieces to the puzzle. I'm looking at ways to help renters who have historically been left out of the puzzle and looking at livability issues. It seems to me that the federal government has these dollars for low-income housing so let's give a preference to places that put the priority on putting all the pieces together: schools, transportation and parks and amenities and everything else. We're looking at the tax bill and ways to squeeze more livability and supply and quality of life out of this."
