"It draws down all the head room that the program is supposed to have to cover expanded services. The money collected will be stacked on top of the Medicaid funding, but it can be swept for other purposes," Hayden said.

Between the insurance premium assessments, the new hard assessment and the shrinking eligibility numbers, Parrish is concerned that the Legislature is trying to create a surplus within the state's Medicaid budget that could then be redirected for other purposes.

Parrish and Hayden reiterated that they were not opposed to paying for health care, but that the funding mechanisms in the current bill did not consider alternatives, like directing healthcare rebates to go back to the state rather than the insurance companies when public money was used to cover the initial outlay or moving public employees to the health care exchange.

"We're not without solutions, and we believe we need healthcare," Parrish said.
