## Parra wins girls tournament

The Celtics went 1-3 in pool play on Friday, with the lone winning coming against Hidden Valley, 46-34. Mc-Nary then lost both of its matches on Saturday, falling to Centennial and Barlow.

"We just couldn't get all 14 of our guys firing at their best at the same time in one dual," Ebbs said. "It kind of came in pockets and waves and as

didn't look so good. We've still got a number of guys just trying to finish off learning their skills and learning how to compete and get to that next level. That's the No. 1 reason why we go there, to wrestle high level competition so we can come back and put the final touches on the team that's getting ready for districts."

Senior Brayden Ebbs didn't wrestle Friday, recovering from a concussion. He returned Saturday and went 2-0 with two pins at 160 pounds.

Enrique Vincent finished 5-1 at 126 pounds with the only loss coming to No. 1 ranked Phillip Kue of Centennial.

"He's (Kue) got a great shot. He got in on our legs," coach Ebbs said. "We couldn't stop it and we couldn't find an answer in the six minutes they gave us but we'll go back and find an answer this week. Wrestling is not that much


