

# Vincent goes 5-1 at Oregon Classic

## Parra wins girls tournament

McNary went to the Oregon Classic in Redmond on Jan. 12-13 to face the best teams in the state.

The level of competition did not disappoint as the Celtics went 1-5.

"Right now we're just going through some lumps and bruises," McNary head coach Jason Ebbs said. "We're trying to put together the best line-up we can put out there, have some injury issues that we're dealing with, some other issues keeping some kids out of our lineup."

The Celtics went 1-3 in pool play on Friday, with the lone winning coming against Hidden Valley, 46-34. McNary then lost both of its matches on Saturday, falling to Centennial and Barlow.

"We just couldn't get all 14 of our guys firing at their best at the same time in one dual," Ebbs said. "It kind of came in pockets and waves and as

a result our dual match score didn't look so good. We've still got a number of guys just trying to finish off learning their skills and learning how to compete and get to that next level. That's the No. 1 reason why we go there, to wrestle high level competition so we can come back and put the final touches on the team that's getting ready for districts."

Senior Brayden Ebbs didn't wrestle Friday, recovering from a concussion. He returned Saturday and went 2-0 with two pins at 160 pounds.

Enrique Vincent finished 5-1 at 126 pounds with the only loss coming to No. 1 ranked Phillip Kue of Centennial.

"He's (Kue) got a great shot. He got in on our legs," coach Ebbs said. "We couldn't stop it and we couldn't find an answer in the six minutes they gave us but we'll go back and find an answer this week. Wrestling is not that much

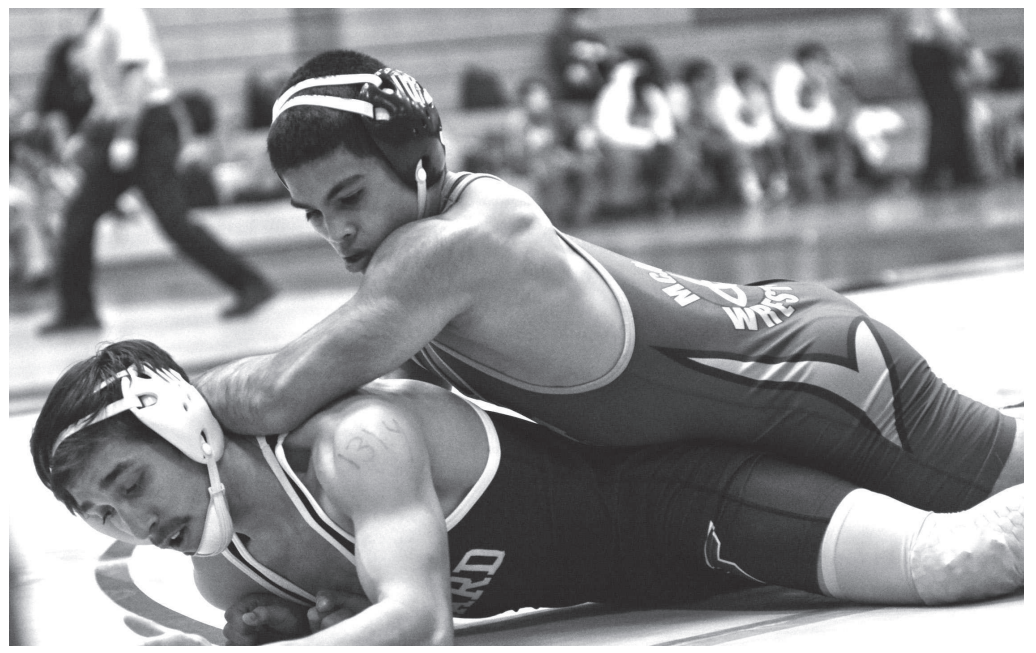
different than any other sport, doesn't matter whether we win or lose that match right now, that's the guy we've got to beat when we get to state in about five weeks. So we'll go to the drawing board and get ready to wrestle that match."

Freshman Grady Burrows went 4-2 at 106 pounds for McNary.

"They were pretty good kids when he lost but he's doing a great job," Ebbs said. "He's a shining star. He's a freshman wrestling varsity and doing well and contributing to our team. He's a guy who should be putting his sights on the state tournament. And if he can get things to go his way, he could have a shot at getting a medal at the state tournament as a freshman."

McNary sophomore Nicollette Parra won the high school girls tournament on Saturday.

At 135 pounds, Parra

earned three pins to get to the finals, where she won by a 6-4 decision.

"She beat a girl (Emma Truex) that's ranked 15th in the nation in the semifinals on her way to winning that tournament," Ebbs said. "She's doing really well for herself."

the third quarter, just wanted to take advantage of the opportunity. "I knew if I went in I had to play my absolute hardest and I couldn't play scared and I just had to be aggressive." Villarreal said. "It was time for me to step up. Coach Kirch was giving me the opportunity to show myself. I saw the lanes and I took them. I got what the defense gave me. I didn't try to force anything. This is the best win I've ever had in my whole life and being actually a part of it, it's crazy."

McNary trailed 20-19 at halftime as both offensives

struggled. But play picked up in the third quarter as the Celtics and Saxons combined to make seven 3-pointers and McNary led 42-40 entering the fourth.

"They had a really good game plan," Kirch said of South Salem. "When you have two dynamic guards (Nielsen-Skinner and Tyler Wadleigh) like that, they are pretty tough. They got us out of our game plan early and did a really nice job defensively and got us out of our rhythm. Credit to our guys for having to adjust a little bit."

McNary led 46-43 with 6:24 remaining in regulation but South Salem made two 3-pointers to take a 49-46 lead. Cavell answered with a 3-pointer to tie the game at 49-49 and the Celtics never trailed again. Lucas Garvey finished with 15 points. Jones added 11.

The win was McNary's seventh in a row this season.

The Celtics won at McMinnville 60-51 on Friday, Jan. 12.

Cavell had 26 points, five rebounds and two assists. Jones added 12 points and eight rebounds. McNary, 12-4 overall, 7-1 in league play and No. 5 in the OSAA power rankings, return to action on Tuesday, Jan. 23 at North Salem.
