

Celtics PR at invitational

McNary sophomore Logun Anderson went into the Willamette Falls Invitational at Pioneer Memorial Stadium in Oregon City on Saturday just wanting to break his brother Austin's mark in the javelin of 150 feet and 8 inches.

He did much more, launching the javelin 157-10, a nearly 13-foot personal record, to place seventh in the event.

"I was really shocked when I heard the 157," Anderson said. "I didn't think that was possible because I'd already PR'd way too much."

Anderson's best throw last season was 129-8.5. He hit 145 in the first meet of this season.

His mark of 157-10 is the second best throw in the Greater Valley Conference this season behind only Forest Grove junior Dominic Funk's 164-7. McNary senior Victor Zavalal is third at 157-7.

"He's supportive," Anderson said of Zavalal. "He wants me to do the best I can and I want him to do the best he can."

Paige Downer had the top finish of any McNary athlete at the invitational, placing third in the pole vault at 9-06. Haley Debban took seventh in the pole vault, clearing 8-06.

Casey Toavs finished fourth in the 300 hurdles in 42.77.

Jose Solorio, Lucas Garvey, Brian Hernandez and Dyami Rios placed fourth in the boys 4x100 relay in 45.24. Solorio, Harvey, Hernandez and Gabriel Martinez then took seventh in the 4x400 relay in 3:40.77. Garvey also finished seventh in the 400 in 53.44.

Ella Repp finished fifth in the 3000 in 11:17.14 and eighth in the 1500 in 5:08.89.

Kennedy Buss, Reyna Terrazas, Isabella Walker and Hannah Mallery took sixth in the girls 4x400 relay in 4:29.06. Buss also placed seventh in the 800 in 2:31.40. Caitlyn Kiefiuk Yates finished eighth in the 100 hurdles in 17.73.

McNary hosted its first league home meet on Wednesday, April 11. Winners included: Rios (100, 12.01), Garvey (200, 24.48), Buss (400, 1:04.97),
