

Man resists arrest after single-car crash

A man with a .13 blood-alcohol level resisted arrest after crashing into a tree in the 5100 block of Verda Lane Northeast.

Keizer police officers responded to a report of a single-vehicle crash about 11 p.m. on Saturday, April 14. The sole occupant of the vehicle fled on foot and was located nearby.

He failed to comply with officer commands and a brief struggle ended with him in custody.

Donovan Lee Anderson, 25, was taken to the Marion County Correctional Facility and charged with driving under the influence of intoxicants, failure to perform the duties of a driver when property is damaged and resisting arrest. Anderson also had two outstanding warrants for failure to appear in court from Salem Municipal Court.

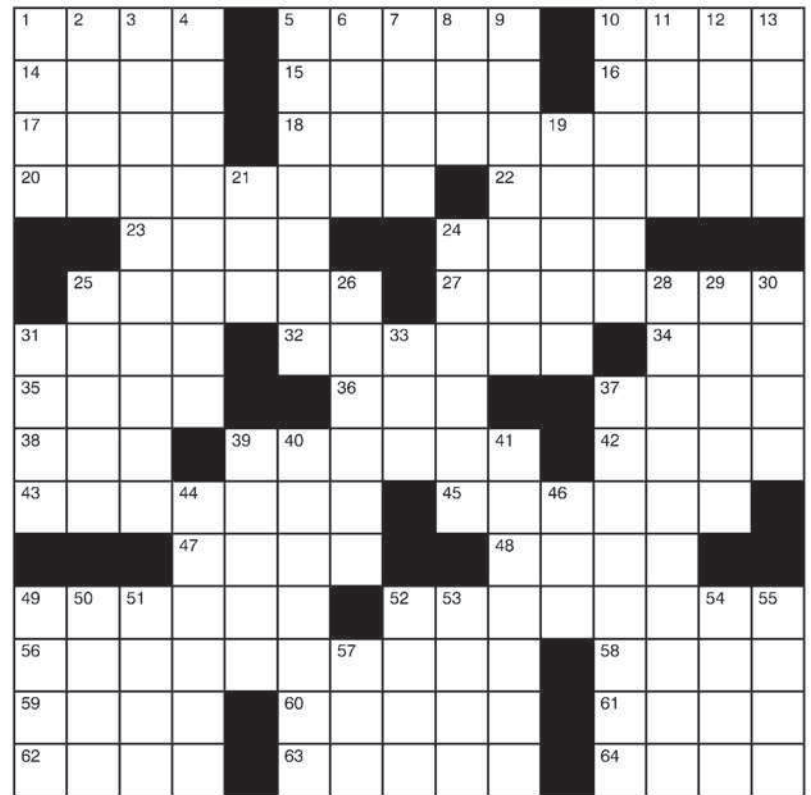
