Candidate filing for city seats opens May 30

The filing period for the positions of mayor and councilor positions 4-6 begins May 30.

The position of mayor, currently held by Cathy Clark is a two-year term. Councilor positions 4, 5, and 6 (held by Roland Herrera, Amy Ryan, and Bruce Anderson, respectively), are four-year terms. All positions are non-partisan and non-paid.

To qualify for these positions, one must be a qualified elector in the State of Oregon and a registered voter in the City of Keizer; in addition, one must have resided in of the City of Keizer continuously for the 12 months preceding the election.

The filing period ends at 5 p.m. on August 28, interested candidates must have all filing requirements completed by this date.

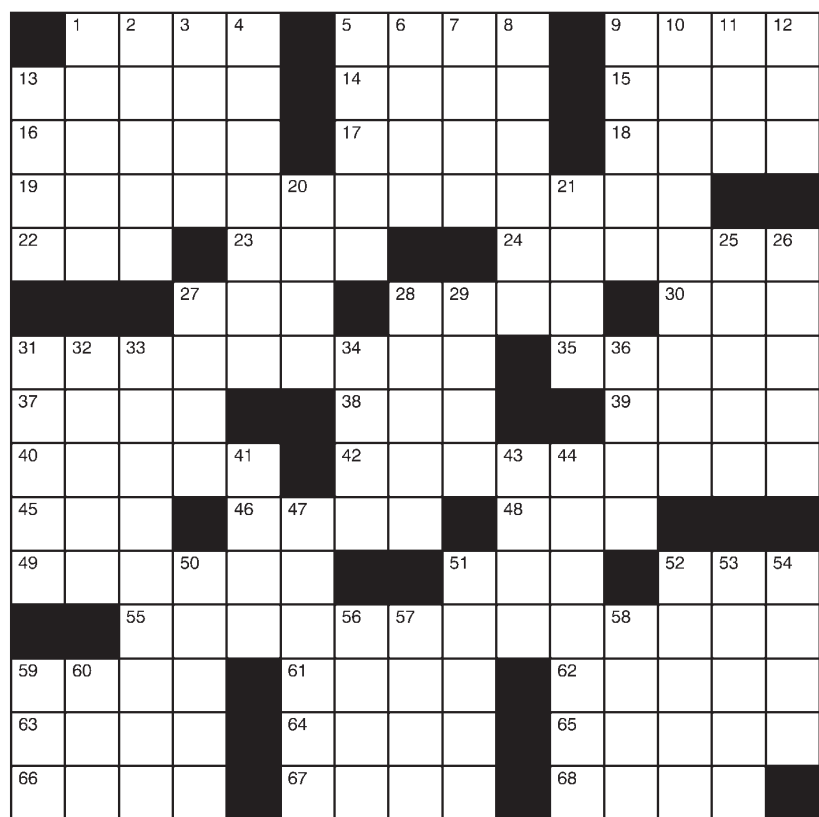
