Woman arrested on drug charges after traffic stop

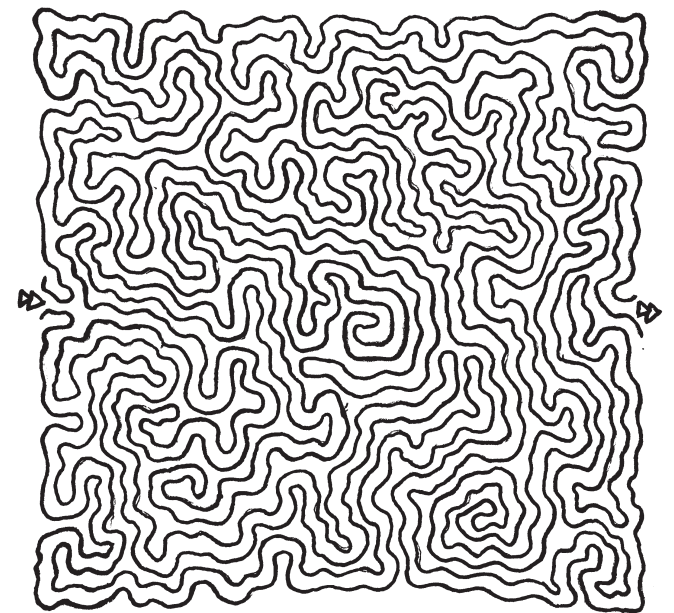
Carolyn, his beloved wife of fifty years, three children and their spouses:
