#### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AMENDMENT TO KEIZER DEVELOPMENT CODE TEXT AMENDMENT CASE NO. 2018-01

**PURPOSE OF HEARING:** The City Council will hold a public hearing to consider proposed revisions to amend multiple sections of the Keizer Development Code to clarify the process and requirements for Keizer Station Master Plan "Amendments". In addition, some minor language changes are needed in the Keizer Station Plan in order to be consistent with the new language of the Keizer Development Code. The following Keizer Development Code Sections are being amended: (Section 2.107 Mixed Use; Section 2.109 Commercial Retail; Section 2.110 Commercial Mixed Use; Section 2.119 General Employment; Section 2.125 Activity Center Overlay Zone; Section 3.101 Summary of Application Types; Section 3.113 Keizer Station Master Plan Review; Section 3.202 General Procedures)
