

Keizer man arrested in Salem murder

A 22-year-old Keizer man was arrested Thursday, Sept. 20, on charges of murder, assault and unlawful use of a weapon.

Julian Pedroza, of Keizer, was arrested by deputies from Marion County Sheriff's Office. Pedroza is suspected in the Sept. 2 shooting of 30-year-old Omisael Jacobo, a resident of Scio.

shortly before midnight in the 2100 block of Lancaster Drive Northeast. Jacobo was transported to Salem Hospital the night of the shooting but succumbed to his wounds on Sept. 19.

Pedroza is being held at Marion County Correctional Facility without bail while awaiting further court proceedings.

Job gains below average

The Salem metropolitan statistical area's (MSA) unemployment rate was 4.1 percent in August, essentially unchanged from its revised July rate of 4.0 percent. Oregon's statewide unemployment rate was 3.8 percent in August, essentially unchanged from its revised rate in July of 3.9 percent.



Salem's August employment gains were smaller than normal. Salem gained an estimated 1,600 jobs in August when an increase of roughly 1,700 would be expected, meaning seasonally adjusted nonfarm employment decreased 100. Salem's employment was 15,500, or 10.1 percent, above its pre-recession employment peak, which occurred in February

2008. Employment in the Salem MSA grew 5,300 over the past year, a 3.2 percent increase. Salem's growth outpaced the state and the nation. Oregon's employment grew 2.2 percent over the past year. Nationally, employment was up 1.7 percent over the past 12 months. Salem's private sector added 6,600 jobs over the past year, growing 5.3 percent. The public sector shed 1,300 jobs, declining 3.3 percent.



The fastest-growing major private-sector industries over the past year included: mining and logging (+100 jobs); construction (+1,100 jobs); and leisure and hospitality (+800 jobs).
