West Salem shuts out Saxons

West Salem (3-3) relied on its running game and defense to shut out South Salem 25-0 on Friday, Oct. 5.

Jake Tinseth led the attack, rushing for 151 yards and a touchdown on 18 carries.

Quarterback Simon Thompson rushed for 95 yards and two touchdowns and threw an 11-yard touchdown pass to Micah Pugh in the second quarter.

South Salem (2-4) finished with just 69 yards rushing and 95 passing.

Ryan Rickman had 25 yards on nine carries and Zach Case caught two passes for 65 yards.

The Saxons play at Oregon City (2-4) this Friday at 7 p.m.

After getting close at South Salem and McNary, the Olympians finally get their first victory.

West Salem at Mountain View

While the Cougars have the better record, the Titans have played a much more difficult schedule with games against Lake Oswego and Sheldon. The last time West Salem played a Bend school, the Titans defeated the Lava Bears by 29 points on

Sept. 7. West Salem should have similar success against Mountain View as the Titans show they're the team to beat in the Mountain Valley Conference.

McNary at Bend

The Lava Bears are a shining example of just how flawed OSAA's power rankings system is. Bend enters the game No. 10, ahead of No. 12 West Salem, who the Lava Bears lost to 56-27. While Bend is benefiting from a 5-1 record, it just hasn't played nearly as strong a schedule as West Salem or its next opponent—McNary. The Lava Bears do have a one-point win over North Medford, who dominated McNary to open the season. Bend also defeated South Salem in a game the Saxons led in the fourth quarter. The Lava Bears belong somewhere in the 20-25 range of the power rankings, not the top 10, and McNary, riding high off its first in of the season, will put them there.

“Our defense stepped up so much,” Barker said. “They shut down their run game completely and made them pass and we knew that’s

“We knew what they were going to do,” McNary senior lineman Joshua Schmeltzer said. “They were going to

run up the middle and try to push it down our throats and we just met the challenge and came together.”

Barker completed 16 of 26 passes for 185 yards.

Harris caught three passes for 95 yards.

Walling rushed for 41 yards on 14 carries.

The win was McNary’s

first over Sprague since 2014.

“We knew this was going to be a tough game,” Barker said. “We knew it was going to be a fight.”

“In previous years, we hadn’t beat them recently so that just fueled the fire. It made that win so much better, that feeling.”
