

Man struck, killed in crosswalk

A 55-year-old Salem man was struck and killed while crossing River Road North near the Cummings Lane North intersection Friday, Nov. 30.

Preliminary investigations found Daniel Kelley Tibbot, of Salem, was crossing in a marked crosswalk about 12:45 p.m. when he was struck by a 2009 Ford F-150 driven by Chester Clark, 79, of Keizer.

Clark had been traveling eastbound on Cummings Lane and was making a left turn north onto River Road. It appeared Tibbot had a walk signal and the right-of-way when he was hit by the truck, Keizer police officials said.

A crew from Keizer Fire District transported Tibbot to Salem Health where he died of his injuries. Clark remained on the scene and cooperated with police in the investigation.

With the assistance of the Keizer Public Works Department both northbound lanes of River Road were closed from Manbrin Drive North to Dietz Avenue NE.

The investigation was continuing at press time and in-

Involved the Marion County Sheriff's Office, Oregon State Police and the Marion County District Attorney's Office.

Once complete, the district attorney's office will determine whether criminal charges are pursued.

Traffic was reduced to one lane on River Road for more than two hours while the on-scene investigation took place.

20 YEARS AGO

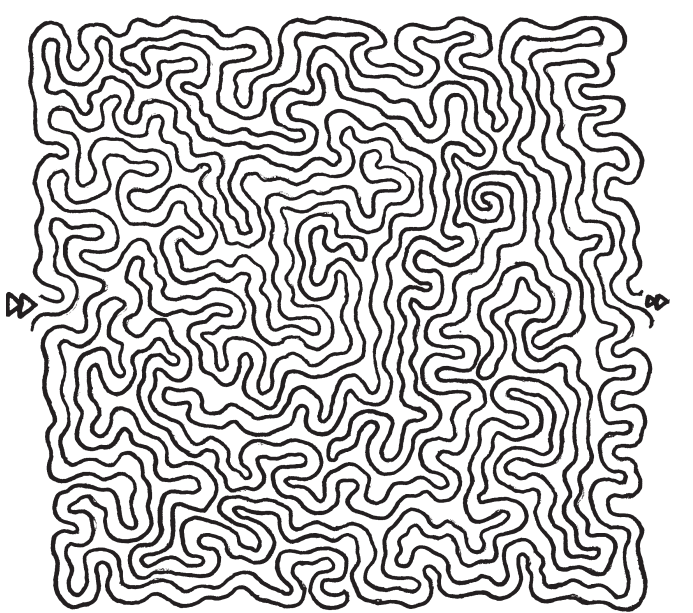
New elementary gets green light
