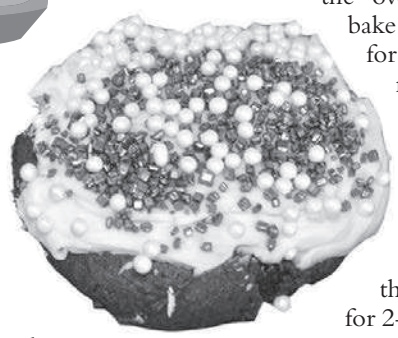


MAKE IT. Holiday cookies

One of the best parts of the holidays is food; and some of the best foods are sweets. They make good gifts and even better snacks. whether you're taking them to an event, giving them as a gift, or eating

them yourself, cookies are a quick and easy way to spread some holiday cheer. Making cookies is almost as exciting as making memories, but you'll need some ingredients first,

Music to bake and sing too
1 box of cake mix
1/3 cup of melted butter
1 egg
and 1 adult for oven operating and memory making



First turn on the music. Then use the adult to preheat the oven to 350. Next, line a baking sheet with parchment paper for easy clean up. Combine all the ingredients in a bowl and whisk together until it becomes doughy. Using a small or medium sized scoop, scoop the cookies onto the pan. Use the adult again to put the cookies into the oven and bake them for 9-11 minutes. Pull them out and let them sit for 2-3 minutes. Now for the fun part, you can decorate them anyway you'd like! 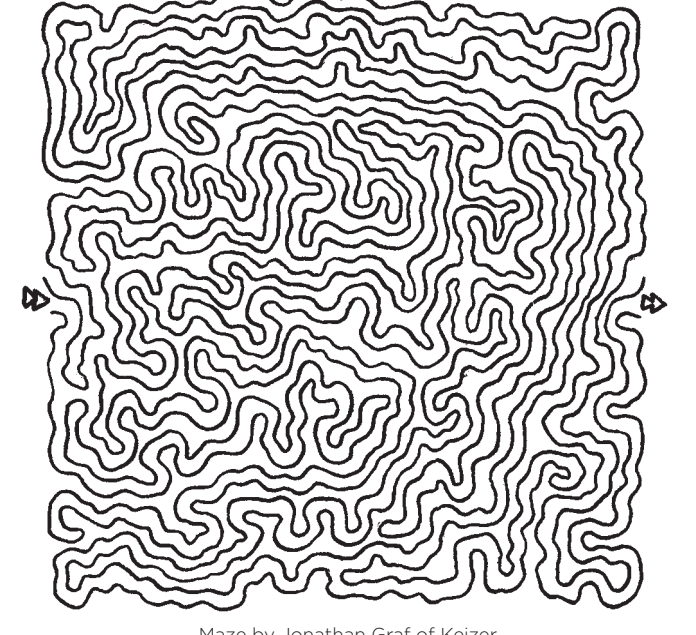
